Improving school attendance

The school is always aiming to improve attendance. Year 10, 11 and 12 are such important years and there is an established link between attendance and academic achievement.

We are open to, and actively encourage parents to bring in learners at any time they are timetabled to be in. Missing registration or a single lesson does not mean the learner has to miss the entire day. If your child misses their taxi please bring them in and we can keep their taxi on to take them home.

The last day of term (Spring term 2) is Friday 31st of March. Learners then return on Monday 17th April (Summer term 1).

There will be bank holidays on Monday 1st May and Monday 8th May. There will an INSET day on the final day of the school year – Monday 24th July.

Informing school of non-attendance

We are required to take a reason for non-attendance for every day that learners are absent. If your child is unable to come to school, please contact the office via phone (02920 529398) or email (schooladmin@brynyderyn.cardiff.sch.uk). This allows us to adhere to legal requirements such as accurate registers and safety/welfare commitments.

We'd like to express our gratitude to parents/carers who have already been contacting school on the occasions that their child is absent.

Strike action and weather impacts on school

Strike action is taking place on Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th of March. Most of ByD and CC are unaffected by this, however a small number of classes that will have a slightly later start time or slightly earlier finishing time. If your child is one of those affected you will be informed via email, via a letter given to your child to take home, and by their form tutor during weekly contact.

We do not expect to close due to the current snowy conditions. Please assume that school is open as normal as taxis remain in place to pick learners up. If in doubt, check the school website and school Twitter page for updates regarding closure.
